May 13, NEW YORK, NY - Today, the National Ethnic Coalition of Organizations (NECO), announced the recipients of the 2017 Ellis Island Medals of Honor. Founder of Reborn International Outreach, James P. Sherlock, legendary astronaut Buzz Aldrin, Governor John Kasich of Ohio, Chairman/ CEO of PepsiCo Indra Nooyi, CNN host/ journalist Fareed Zakaria, CEO of HSN Mindy Grossman, actress/film studio executive Sherry Lansing and chef/ restaurateur Thomas Keller. In its 31st year, the Ellis Island Medal of Honor ceremony took place in the original registry room at Ellis Island where 12 million immigrants



came through hosted by legendary journalist Marvin Scott.

Ellis Island Medal of Honor is awarded to individuals who have made it their mission to share their wealth of knowledge, indomitable courage, boundless compassion, unique talents and selfless generosity with those less fortunate; all while maintaining the traditions of their ethnic heritage as they uphold the ideals and spirit of America.

Since the Medal was founded in 1986 this distinguished honor has been given to seven Presidents of the United States, Nobel Prize recipient Elie Wiesel, Generals Norman Schwarzkopf and Colin Powell, Secretary of State Madeline Albright, Bob Hope; Muhammad Ali, Frank Sinatra; Rosa Parks; Mike Wallace and Mia Farrow.

NECO receives thousands of nominations each year for this award and it's our pleasure to announce that Point Pleasant Beach resident, Jimmy Sherlock has now been awarded the 2017 Ellis Island Medal of Honor.

In the Spirit of Mother Teresa, Jimmy Sherlock established Reborn International Outreach in 2010. Starting in Kenya, Reborn began sponsoring orphans/children in need by paying their school fees and then started taking children who lived on the streets and placed them into a boarding school.

In 2013, under Mr. Sherlock's leadership, Reborn built a hospital from used medical equipment in Bamako, Mali where 1 out of 19 pregnant women die during pregnancy.

In 2015, Jimmy Sherlock created Reborn Fashion Designed By Orphans, which now partners with orphanages in 11 countries, where every child participating will receive a scholarship when they graduate high school to go to college, start a business or learn a trade thus breaking the chain of poverty for that orphan.

In 2016, Mr. Sherlock began collecting laptop computers and distributes them to schools in 3rd world countries. Reborn works with Colleges to connect their students with the children in these 3rd world countries to tutor them thru Skype. This responds to the United Nations Millennium Development Goals (MDG Goal 2) Achieve Universal primary education, (MDG Goal 8) develop a global partnership for development, (MDG Target 18) In cooperation with the private sector, make available the benefits of new technologies, especially information and communications technologies.

The Ellis Island Medal of Honor ranks among the nation's most renowned awards. The U.S. Senate and House of Representatives have officially recognized the Ellis Island Medals of Honor and each year the recipients are listed in the Congressional Record

My name is Job Kariuki. I was born in Burnt Forest town at a place known as Mawingu in 1992 when there were tribal clashes between Kikuyu and Kalenjin community.

Due to these conflicts I lose of my relatives and family friends. We had to run for our safety and so we choose nakuru town which was 45 km from our home in Burnt Forest.

Getting to town was one great challenge since no vehicle was coming or leaving Burnt Forest town. We had to walk to Nakuru. To get to Nakuru we had to abandon the normal tarmac road and traverse via forest for our safety. Many people lose their life due to hash weather which caused lot of diseases.



One morning, after a long night of walking we came head to head with enemy fighters. Many lose their life's and I, my mother and other few were rescued by Kenya defense forces (KDF) and taken to Nakuru showgrounds as refugees.

Due to hardship and peer pressure I joined a gang of robbers where we pickpocketed and robbed people in Nakuru town. I also got into drugs. Life in the street was difficult. I was arrested number of times by the police and arraigned in court.

It was on Tuesday date When I met a white man. His name is Mr. Jimmy .He asked me if I would like to change my life. Without hesitating a agreed. He took me to rehab where I learnt a lot of things.

Thanks To Reborn outreach today, am changed not a drug addict anymore. I look forward to join college to study mechanics.
